

## **PAID INTERNSHIP\*: SECURITY COUNCIL REPORT**

35+ hours per week at \$15 per hour

Security Council Report (SCR) is seeking a full-time intern for a period of six months to start as soon as possible. The internship is renewable.

SCR's mission is to advance the transparency and effectiveness of the UN Security Council. We seek to achieve this by making available timely, balanced, high-quality information about the activities of the Council and its subsidiary bodies; by convening stakeholders to deepen the analysis of issues before the Council and its working methods and performance; by encouraging engagement of the Council with all member states and civil society; and by building capacity on Council practice and procedure through assisting incoming members and other training and assistance programmes. SCR is independent and impartial; it advocates transparency but does not take positions on the issues before the Council.

The intern will be responsible for providing research support to the full time staff. The intern will assist in producing high quality and timely material to be published by SCR, posting SCR publications to its websites (securitycouncilreport.org and whatsinblue.org), proof-reading and fact-checking material for publication. Candidates should have demonstrated skills in research, drafting, and analysis with knowledge of the workings of the Security Council. Candidates with or working towards a graduate degree in international relations, international law, or journalism are strongly preferred. There is also preference for applicants with UN experience; and/or studying the UN or international organisations; and/or have specialised knowledge of an issue before the Security Council. Excellent drafting skills in English are essential. Some knowledge of another of the UN's working languages would be an asset. SCR is seeking candidates who are highly skilled and highly motivated.
